**PURPOSE**

Inform counties that software applications from ADP will be provided on compact disk (CD).

**DISCUSSION**

The Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) supplies software for counties and providers to enter data such as Cost Reports, Net Negotiated Amount (NNA) contract budgets, and Drug Medi-Cal claims. In the past, these software applications have been distributed on diskettes; however, the current versions of the software are too large to fit on diskettes. Starting with the upcoming Final Budget Amendment, you will receive a CD rather than a diskette to use for installing the program. The data produced by ADP's software applications will fit on diskette, so it is not necessary to have a CD writer.

The minimum computer configuration required for these software applications are:

**Hardware**

- IBM compatible personal computer with 100 MHz processor
- 32 megabytes RAM (64 megabytes recommended)
- 100 megabyte available hard disk space
- CD-ROM or DVD-ROM drive
- VGA monitor
- Mouse
- Windows-compatible printer (Laser recommended)
- Connection to Internet to send data through the Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) InfoNet – 56-Kilobytes/second (recommended)

**Software**

- Windows 95, Windows 98 or Windows NT 4.0
- Paradox Runtime Version 9 (ADP supplies)
- Paradox Runtime Billing Program (ADP supplies)
