PURPOSE

The purpose of this bulletin is to clarify instructions for counties and direct contract providers regarding requirements for the submission of automated Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) claims.

Enclosed is the revised "Paradox V9, DMC Billing System Fiscal Year 2000/2001, County/Direct Contract Diskette". This diskette replaces the original diskette, which was mailed with ADP Bulletin [00-20](#), dated June 19, 2000. The revision is to correct an unforeseen corrupted file found on some of the original diskettes.

DISCUSSION**PARADOX COUNTIES:**

If you had problems with the ASCII button not working with your County/Direct Contract Diskette, please follow these instructions:

Uninstall (see updated instructions enclosed) the original version of the County/Direct Contract Diskette and install the revised (August 18, 2000), County/Direct Contract Diskette. Some counties must install this diskette to load the files from the DMC Provider diskette(s) and generate the ASCII text file(s). The ASCII text files are the only Paradox-generated DMC claim files that will be processed by the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP).

Refer to the "County/Direct Contract Version 9 User Instructions" manual which was mailed June 19, 2000 with ADP Bulletin 00-20 for assistance in installing and using the Paradox V9, County/Direct Contract system. In addition, enclosed are revised pages of the "Provider Data Entry Diskette User Instructions" and the "County/Direct Contract Version 9 User

Instructions” manuals. Please replace the appropriate manual pages per the replacement instructions at the top of each enclosure page.

DIRECT CONTRACT PROVIDERS ONLY:

All direct contract providers must submit ASCII text file(s) for submission to ADP. To do this, please follow the instructions below:

Install the revised County/Direct Contract Diskette enclosed. The ASCII text files are the only Paradox-generated DMC claim files that will be processed by the ADP.

Refer to the “County/Direct Contract Version 9 User Instructions” manual, which was mailed June 19, 2000 with ADP Bulletin [00-20](#), for assistance in installing and using the Paradox V9, County/Direct Contract system. Also enclosed are the revised pages of the “Provider Data Entry Diskette User Instructions” and “County/Direct Contract Version 9 User Instructions” manuals. Please replace the appropriate manual pages with the revised pages, according to the replacement instructions at the top of each enclosure page.

Thank you for your patience and teamwork during implementation of the Paradox Drug Medical billing process for Fiscal Year 2000-01.
