**PURPOSE**

This bulletin transmits the Fiscal Year (FY) 2001-02 Governor's Budget Allocation to counties for informational and planning purposes. The enclosed allocation of State and federal funds is contingent upon enactment of the FY 2001-02 Budget Act, federal appropriations, and executed State/County contracts. Incorporated in this bulletin are three Exhibits: (1) a brief funding and program overview, (2) a statewide detailed worksheet, and (3) individual county allocation notice.

- \$129,496,700 State General Funds, of which \$64.4 million is for Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) services;
- \$10,815,000 Parolee Services Network funds (Reimbursement);
- \$202,706,999 federal Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) Block Grant funds; and
- \$3,647,000 federal Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities (SDFSC) funds.

**DISCUSSION**

Major changes pertaining to the FY 2001-02 Governor's (Preliminary) Budget Allocations are:

**DMC**

This is the first year the appropriation for the DMC program is developed based on caseload, rates, services, and utilization patterns. The estimate for the appropriation will be reviewed, and may be adjusted, by the Legislature in May before enactment of the final Budget Act. Any adjustments in the May Revise will then be incorporated into the Budget Act allocation.

**SAPT Block Grant**

The Department received notice of a SAPT Block Grant increase of approximately \$11.9 million for the current federal fiscal year (FFY) 2001 award. Because the FFY 2001 grant award notice was received after the release of the Governor's Budget, it is not reflected in this Preliminary Allocation.
