PURPOSE

This bulletin transmits the proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2009-2010 reimbursement rates for Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) services. The proposed rates are contingent upon Legislative action and approval of the FY 2009-2010 Budget Act.

The Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) developed the FY 2009-2010 rates using the normal methodology, then reduced those rates by ten percent to comply with the Governor's May 2009 Revision proposal.

The rates will be effective July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010, subject to any further action by the Legislature or the Governor.

DISCUSSION

Exhibit A includes the proposed reimbursement rates for FY 2009-2010, which reflect ADP's analysis of costs and units of service for the DMC treatment modalities. Each year ADP develops new reimbursement rates for DMC services. These rates were developed in accordance with Section 14021.6 of the Welfare and Institutions Code and Section 11758.42 of the Health and Safety Code.
