**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this bulletin is to revise the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs= (ADP) Bulletin No. 98-13 regarding information pertaining to the Department of Corrections (CDC) programs.

**DISCUSSION**

ADP Bulletin No. 98-13 stated that ADP would no longer license the Community Prisoner Mother Programs (CPMPs) because the residents are under the custody of CDC and governed by the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 15. Following the issuance of the ADP Bulletin, ADP was contacted by a number of providers who voiced concern that ADP would no longer license CPMPs.

The Department convened a meeting of providers, CDC, and county representatives to address and discuss the concerns and issues. After listening to the concerns and evaluating the issues, ADP has revised its policy. The Department will license CPMPs that fall under the following requirements and restrictions:

- X The facility is located in a community setting and is free standing.
- X Alcohol and drug services as defined in CCR, Title 9, Chapter 5, Section 10501 (a)(5), are provided on site.
- X The facility hires its own staff.
- X The facility is not staffed with CDC personnel.
- X The facility is not secured (i.e., the women in these facilities are able to leave the

premises without being restrained or detained).
