PURPOSE

This bulletin transmits an allocation document for an additional \$5 million of Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) Block Grant discretionary funds on a one-time basis for Fiscal Year (FY) 1999-00. You will be notified by a supplemental bulletin with a revised statewide allocation once the Legislature has reviewed and approved the use of these funds.

DISCUSSION

The \$5 million SAPT discretionary funds were originally directed to the Department of Social Services for alcohol and drug treatment and recovery services to California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) clients. The funds initially came from a federal increase and were never allocated through the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) to counties. Therefore, these one-time funds are considered new and are allocated using the standard allocation methodology for new funds (\$2,500 per million, with the balance per capita). Because these funds are from the Federal Fiscal Year 1999 grant, they must be expended by September 30, 2000. These funds do not affect the Prevention or HIV Set Aside amounts.
