- AB 2071 Most Frequently Asked Questions: These questions have been raised from a number of individuals in various forms of communication. We believe this Question and Answer document answers many concerns regarding the implementation of AB 2071.
- Non-Automated Claiming Procedures for the D/MC Billing System: This document is designed for those providers that will continue to submit their D/MC claims on paper.
- D/MC Rates for FY 1997-98: This document identifies the D/MC modalities, Service Function Codes, the type of Unit of Service (UOS), the fixed or maximum allowance UOS rates, and county administrative costs for Fiscal Year 1997-98.
