SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 1997-98 Monthly Interim Payment Claims

Enclosed is the revised Monthly Interim Payment Claim (MIPC) form and instructions for Fiscal Year (FY) 1997-98. This form is for your use in claiming the State General Fund (SGF) portion of your projected Drug/Medi-Cal (D/MC) expenditures.

The form has been revised for the following reasons:

1. The structure of how Narcotic Treatment Programs (NTP) are to be reimbursed is different than the other D/MC modalities. For NTP providers, fixed rates must be claimed. Actual cost up to the maximum allowance rate for the other D/MC modalities may be claimed.
2. For direct contract providers that claim for NTP services, ADP will withhold state administrative funds of \$.54 per unit of service for non-perinatal services and \$.62 per unit of service for perinatal services. These projected administrative costs apply only to the type of service, i.e., Methadone or LAAM, and not to individual or group counseling.
3. Effective July 1, 1997, the Federal Medicaid Assistance Percentage of payment for minor consent for perinatal services will change. For the time period July 1, 1997, through September 30, 1997, the federal share is 50.23 percent and the state share is 49.77 percent. For the time period October 1, 1997, through June 30, 1998, the federal share will be 51.23 percent and the state share will be 48.77 percent. For non-perinatal minor consent services, the state share will continue to be 100 percent.
4. Effective October 1, 1997, the Federal Medical Assistance Percentage for all other D/MC services will change from 50.23 percent to 51.23 percent. For the time period July 1, 1997, through September 30, 1997, the federal share is 50.23 percent; and for the time period October 1, 1997, through June 30, 1998, the federal share will be 51.23 percent.

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The funds identified on the MIPC form are not reimbursable until your FY 1997-98 D/MC contract is fully executed and the State Budget is signed by the Governor.
