In our June 23, 1997, letter (ADP #97-36), the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) introduced the Independent Peer Review Project (IPRP) and announced that the California Association of Addiction Recovery Resources (CAARR) was the contractor selected to implement the IPRP.

During the first year of the contract, CAARR will conduct independent peer reviews in 30 randomly-selected, residential programs identified on the enclosed list. It may be necessary for CAARR, first, to contact the County Alcohol and Drug Program Administrators to determine the philosophy of the programs to be reviewed (i.e., social model, therapeutic community, etc.). Then, approximately three weeks prior to the review date, CAARR will contact the randomly selected programs, in writing, to both solicit and provide information regarding the IPRP and the actual review.

We ask that you give CAARR your support and cooperation. The future of the alcohol and other drugs field will benefit from the information garnered during this worthy undertaking.
