A. CalOMS Tx Report Updates

1. Repeat Report Footers

Repeat report footers and run date/time have been added to the Open Admission and Open Provider Reports. The right side footer on every page will continue to have the page number and the total number of pages indicated.

2. Capacity Constraint on Excel Generated Reports

When a CalOMS Tx system user submits a file export report request to Information Technology Web Services (ITWS) and the requested report has too many lines for Excel processing, an error message will be sent to the user so they can alter the report to be smaller in size and rerun it, without requiring DBA intervention.

For Excel export errors, the CalOMS Tx system user will receive an email. The message will read as follows:

"The report you requested cannot be generated because it exceeds the maximum number of rows allowed in an Excel spreadsheet. Please request a different format or change the selection criteria to get a smaller result set."

### 3. Report Processing Error Message

CalOMS Tx system users will receive an email for system errors that stop report processing. The message will read as follows:

“The <name of report> report you requested at <time report was requested> cannot be transferred to ITWS because of an internal system error. The CalOMS Tx support team has been notified.”

### B. New CalOMS Tx Error Code Messages

- Error Message 139 for (LEG-1) Criminal Justice Status will be: “Criminal Justice Status must be 1 when Source of Referral (7, 8, 10, 12) is from the Court System.”
- Error Message 211 for (MED-7) Medication Prescribed will be: “Medication Prescribed must be 2, 3, 4, or 5 when Provider is NTP only.”
- Error Message 475 for (TRN-1) Type of Form will be: “Annual Update cannot be submitted after the matching admission record has been Discharged.”

### C. CalOMS Tx Narcotic Treatment Program (NTP) Reporting Information Update

Many NTP providers are not entering a type of medication for (MED-7) Medication Prescribed as Part of Treatment. A NTP record without an identified medication is counted as an outpatient admission, consequently reducing the NTP admission count and not providing the federally required information on opioid replacement therapy.

A NTP Maintenance admission is created from two data elements, (ADM-4) Type of Service (1) Outpatient Drug Free *plus* (MED-7) Medication Prescribed as Part of Treatment (2) Methadone or (3) LAAM or (4) Buprenorphine (Subutex) or (5) Buprenorphine (Suboxone).

An NTP Detox admission is created from two data elements, (ADM-4) Type of Service, (3) Outpatient Detoxification *plus* (MED-7) Medication Prescribed as Part of Treatment, (2) Methadone or (3) LAAM or (4) Buprenorphine (Subutex) or (5) Buprenorphine (Suboxone).

Records submitted for NTP Detox or NTP Maintenance must have a value other than “none” or “other” for (MED-7) Medication Prescribed as Part of Treatment or it will be rejected.

This edit will not affect providers that provide both NTP and Outpatient treatment services as the processing system cannot determine if the client is an Outpatient client or data is missing. Providers off both services are encouraged to monitor their data closely.

To correct existing admissions records providers will need to submit resubmission of admissions records as appropriate.

#### D. CalOMS Tx Office of Criminal Justice Collaboration (OCJC), Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act (SACPA) Relational Edit Change

When admission records in CalOMS Tx have an (ADM-5) Source of Referral indicating that the court system referred the individual, but the (LEG-1) Criminal Justice Status on the same record indicates that the person has no involvement with the Criminal Justice System, an error will occur.

A new relational edit was made between (ADM-5) Source of Referral and Criminal Justice Status (LEG-1).

If (ADM-5) Source of Referral is (7) SACPA / Prop 36 / OTP / Probation, (8) SACPA / Prop 36 / OTP / Parole, (10) Adult Felon Drug Court, or (12) Non-SACPA Court / Criminal Justice, then (LEG-1) Criminal Justice Status cannot equal (1) No criminal justice involvement.

#### E. Changes to (ADM-5) Source of Referral Codes – Criminal Justice

To make a clearer distinction between criminal justice referral codes, **beginning July 1, 2009** the codes will be changed to the following definitions:

8	SACPA Parole	SACPA / Prop 36 / OTP / Parole
10	Drug Court Partnership (DCP)	Adult Felon Drug Court
11	Comprehensive Drug Court Implementation (CDCI)	Dependency Drug Court
14	Dependency Court / CPS	Child Protective Services

#### F. Missing Records in Special Populations Table

Information was missing from the Special Populations reports. Some “type of service” codes did not have associated records in this report when it was expected that they should. A new script to find and create missing Disabled Special Populations was created and implemented. (Note: This change will not impact CalOMS Tx users.)

## G. Annual Update Data Submission

A new edit has been added rejecting Annual Update records that are submitted after a service treatment episode is discharged.

The new Error Code 475 for (TRN-1) Type of Form will read: "Annual Update cannot be submitted after the matching Admission record has been Discharged."

If multiple Annual Updates are submitted, the system will always count and use the data from the last Annual Update submitted.
