A letter of intent is requested by the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) from those counties interested in applying for additional funding appropriated in the Budget Act for FY 2006-07 for dependency drug court (DDC) programs. The \$3.0 million in additional funding is for the implementation, planning, or expansion of new or existing DDC programs under the Comprehensive Drug Court Implementation (CDCI) Grant. The letter of intent is not binding on either the county or ADP. Failure to submit a letter of intent disqualifies the county from being considered for the additional \$3.0 million for CDCI dependency drug court programs.
