# Resource Center

CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOL & DRUG PROGRAMS

**The Resource Center (RC)** maintains a comprehensive collection of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug (ATOD) prevention and treatment information. The following information is a brief description of services provided to California residents at no cost through a Clearinghouse, full-service Library, Internet communication links, information and referral system, and conferences. Additionally, information is available to national and international customers through the ADP website.

### Clearinghouse

ATOD booklets, pamphlets, research papers, posters, technical manuals, and other printed materials are available upon request. The Clearinghouse provides information to community and school organizations, families and individuals, prevention and treatment programs, and government agencies. Printed materials are continually updated as new information is identified.

### Lending Services

A collection of specialized ATOD reference sources including books, journals, reports, and audiovisual materials. These materials are available for loan directly to employees of government agencies and organizations funded through county alcohol and drug programs and/or licensed and certified through ADP. In addition, materials are available to lending libraries through an interlibrary loan.
