The Resource Center (RC) maintains a comprehensive collection of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug (ATOD) prevention and treatment information. The following information is a brief description of services provided to California residents at no cost through the Information Clearinghouse, Lending Services, Conference Services, and Information Services. Additionally, information is available to local, national and international customers through the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Program's (ADP) website.

Information Clearinghouse

ATOD booklets, pamphlets, research papers, posters, technical manuals, and other printed materials are available upon request. The Clearinghouse provides information to community and school organizations, families and individuals, prevention and treatment programs, and government agencies. Printed materials are continually updated as new information is identified. The Clearinghouse currently has nearly 700 different publications available. Lending Services

Lending Services carries a collection of specialized ATOD reference sources including books, journals, reports, and audiovisual materials. These materials are available for loan directly to employees of government agencies, schools, and organizations funded through county alcohol and drug programs
