**NOTICE OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY REGULATORY ACTION
COUNSELOR CERTIFICATION – CERTIFYING ORGANIZATIONS**

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code Section 11346.4(a)(1), the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) is providing public notice of a proposed emergency rulemaking amending Section 13035, Title 9 of the California Code of Regulations. The proposed change will amend Section 13035 by extending to September 30, 2007 the deadline for organizations that certify alcohol and other drug counselors to become accredited. A copy of the text of the proposed regulatory action and a finding of emergency are enclosed.

If you have any comments regarding the need for emergency rulemaking, please submit your comments to the Office of Administrative Law, 300 Capitol Mall, Suite 1250, Sacramento, CA 95814. All comments must be received by 5 p.m. on May 14, 2007.

At this time, please limit your comments to the need for emergency rulemaking. Following the close of the five-day emergency comment period, ADP will provide a subsequent 45-day public comment period, during which you may submit comments on the policy contained in the proposed regulatory change. You will receive a separate notice of that public comment period.
