SUBJECT: Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000
Chapter 2.5, Title 9, California Code of Regulations

Enclosed is a copy of the Readoption and Amendment of Chapter 2.5, Title 9, California Code of Regulations. The regulations, as approved by the Office of Administrative Law and filed with the Secretary of State, became effective March 22, 2001.

These readopted regulations reflect the input from counties and the Statewide Advisory Group to the initial emergency regulations which were adopted December 26, 2000. The major changes address requirements for the county trust fund, allowable costs, renovations and remodeling and accessibility for persons with disabilities.
