SUBJECT: Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000  
Chapter 2.5, Title 9, California Code of Regulations

The purpose of this letter is to transmit a copy of Chapter 2.5, Title 9, California Code of Regulations, as amended. The regulations, as approved by the Office of Administrative Law and filed with the Secretary of State, became effective April 25, 2001.

These regulations contain the requirements for ongoing implementation of the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 (SACPA). The regulations include: 1) county plan requirements; 2) list of the data elements to be collected for the purposes of SACPA required program administration monitoring, and evaluation; and 3) county reporting requirements. The regulations and other information on SACPA are available on the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) web site, [www.adp.ca.gov](http://www.adp.ca.gov). Additional information on developing county plans is being distributed under separate cover.
