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2002-03, ADP is expanding SRIS to accept electronic submission of all required plan elements. It will accept the narrative and board of supervisors' resolutions as well as fiscal, capacity, and client projections. The system is also being expanded to include the reporting requirements for the SATTA Program. ADP expects to release these enhanced automation capabilities in early April 2002. Templates for the fiscal, capacity, and client projection sections of the plan for State FY 2002-03 will be distributed in mid-March, along with an updated SRIS user manual.

Lead agencies must show they have collaborated with stakeholders as they developed their State Fiscal Year 2002-03 county plans. ADP considers ongoing collaboration vital to successful implementation and operation of SACPA. Sections 9515 and 9520, Chapter 2.5, Division 4, Title 9, CCR, contains the requirements for collaboration.
