SUBJECT: Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act/Substance Abuse Offender  
Treatment Program Fiscal Year 2007-08 Plan/Application Submission

REFERENCE: Health and Safety Code Section 11999.6, 11999.30

This letter transmits Fiscal Year (FY) 2007-08 allocation and county plan information for both the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act (SACPA) and the Substance Abuse Offender Treatment Program (OTP).

The Governor's FY 2007-08 proposed budget "reduces 2007-08 Proposition 36 funding by \$60 million and utilizes this funding to provide an increase of \$35 million to the OTP and savings of \$25 million on a one-time basis... If the reforms to Proposition 36 agreed to by the Legislature are not implemented, the Administration will revise its budget proposal in the May Revision to move all remaining Proposition 36 funding to the OTP."

The Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) will release three funding scenarios:

- \$120M SACPA and \$25M OTP with county match
- \$60M SACPA and \$60M OTP with county match
- \$120M OTP with county match

ADP will not require submission of a SACPA county plan or OTP application until after the release of FY 2007-08 Budget Act.
