SUBJECT: FY 2008-09 Supplemental Allocation for the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 (SACPA)

REFERENCE: ACLA Letter No. 08-04: FY 2008-09 Preliminary Allocations  
Health and Safety Code Section 11999.6.1

This letter transmits Fiscal Year (FY) 2008-09 supplemental allocation for the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 (SACPA).

In June 2006, the budget trailer bill (Chapter 75, 2006 Statutes) required the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) to withhold funds from counties and redistribute 75 percent of those funds to counties. The remaining 25 percent was reserved to adjust for actual rather than projected unencumbered funds. Additionally, the trailer bill allowed ADP to create additional allocations to counties through reconsideration of unencumbered funds, audit recoveries, returned funds or otherwise.

The remaining 25 percent of withheld funds totaling \$145,848, returned funds of \$152,616 and audit recoveries totaling \$700,000 are available for distribution to the counties. Supplemental funds of \$997,849 shall be allocated to counties with unencumbered funds of 20 percent or less of their FY 2008-09 allocation in ratio to their FY 2009-10 preliminary SACPA allocation.

Although FY 2008-09 supplemental allocations were not considered in the calculation of unencumbered funds for the FY 2009-10 preliminary allocations, the supplemental funds must be included in the SACPA county plan as carryover into FY 2009-10 unless spent by June 30, 2009.
